Re: Plan Mid Devon Issues Consultation Regulation 18

Mid Devon District Council is preparing a new Local Plan for Mid Devon (excluding the small part of the district within Dartmoor National Park), which we have called 'Plan Mid Devon'. This will include a vision and strategy for how the district will be planned, policies that will guide development, the use of land and buildings and a map that will show where development can take place and what parts of the district will be protected.

Help us Plan Mid Devon by telling us what issues you think are most relevant and important to you and your community, and which should be given the greatest priority in Mid Devon for the period to 2043.

Comments are invited on the Plan Mid Devon Issues Paper, its associated Sustainability Appraisal and Equality Impact Assessment Scoping Reports. Please find enclosed a copy of a poster publicising this consultation, we would be very grateful if you could put up this poster on a public noticeboard in your area.

The consultation runs from 31st January – 28th March 2022. This is the first opportunity for you to find out more about this new Local Plan and help us prepare it.
