9.4 22/00907/FULL Retention of disused quarry for use as two firing ranges at Devon & Cornwall constabulary Pondground Quarry.
This meeting was held to discuss with residents any further objections that should be raised prior to the MDDC Planning Committee Meeting on Wednesday 27th September.

The following points were raised:

- Residents were very frustrated that the firing demonstration laid on for the new Planning Committee members did not reflect a true day's shooting that they have been subjected to for many years.
- The members were taken to several sites around the Parish but missed out on several places where the noise is particularly loud and with only 10 police firing without the usual backup of a further 10 ready to shoot there was always a gap when weapons were loaded.
- This should be a new application not a continuation of a temporary permission that lapsed over 8 years ago.
- The previous application breached conditions but were never enforced by MDDC.
- If shooting is to be permitted on this site it must be stipulated it is for Devon & Cornwall Constabulary only
- There has been no shooting on this site since May 22 and the police themselves admitted that they had not been in breach of their training and policy agreements as they had stated.

The Parish Council confirmed that they will be issuing a statement to be read out in the Planning Committee. Clerk to register the request to the Committee Clerk and inform residents how to register.

There being no other business the meeting closed at 7.40pm.
